Dear Dr. Bokovoy:

It is a pleasure to inform you that your manuscript has been accepted for publication in the ENRS Supplement to *Nursing Research*. Enclosed is an Author's Agreement form which you should complete, have each author sign, and return to the Editor at the address above as soon as possible. You may make copies as necessary. If any of the figures are copyrighted, please obtain permission to reprint from the publisher of the article and return this along with your signed copyright agreement to the Editor.

Some editing may be done on your manuscript before it is forwarded to the publisher. Please send a new copy of your manuscript which includes the requested revisions in an email to Sherry at handfing@email.unc.edu by November 11. Please make the following revisions:

1. Opening heading: Pronouns throughout could be minimized for a research paper.
2. Page 4, Organization: The first paragraph should be the one at the bottom of the page under the Heading. Just move that to an Introduction; then have organizational context and Project Goal.
3. Page 5, Insert Background literature or the heading from page 4 "Cooperative Learning Approaches" and start with the first paragraph.
4. Historically...Avoid the last single sentence paragraph on page 6 under this discussion.
5. Page 8 seems out of sync...Literature Review of what? It seems it was a part of team building and should be integrated as a strategy of that process.
6. Page 17, Summary or implications should be called out as a separate heading with more than a one sentence statement.
7. Figures 1 and 2 need titles.
8. Page 15, paragraph one belongs in methods; results in Table 3 should be briefly summarized and pointed to from the text.
9. Page 15, last paragraph - any internal consistency reliability coefficients for each factor?
10. Page 16, discussion, paragraph 1: be more specific about what kind of research methods.
11. Page 16, last paragraph, one of the specified limitations is that the authors state that they did not address construct validity. This is an error. Factor analysis, which was conducted, is a method for addressing construct validity.

Please also note the Final Checklist. Before publication, you will receive your typeset manuscript from the managing editor for your review. Printing schedules require that you return the copy to the publisher within 48 hours of receipt. Please notify us immediately of any change in your address so that unnecessary delay can be avoided.
